



Notice of Race for the International Moth Lowrider Inland National Championships at Burton Sailing Club on 10th & 11th October 2026

1. Rules

- 1.1. The races will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2025-2028 and the Event Supplementary Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2. Competitors should note that Burton Sailing Club implements the RYA Racing Charter and that they will be required to undertake to sail in compliance with the Charter, which can be found at the front of the RYA rule book.
- 1.3. By entering and attending this event, all persons agree to abide by the Rules of Burton Sailing Club.

2. Advertising

- 2.1. Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority. If this rule is broken, World Sailing Regulation 20.9.2 applies.

3. Conditions of Entry

- 3.1. The race is open to any International Moth Lowrider Dinghy
- 3.2. Entrants must be members of the Class Association at the time of entering.
- 3.3. **Entry fee will be £35.**
- 3.4. Eligible helms may enter on the day, but pre-registration is requested via:

4. Schedule

- 4.1. The first race start times for each day are scheduled to be as follows with the warning signal being 5 minutes prior to the start time.
- 4.2. The racing schedule below may be amended on the days by the PRO in consultation with Class Committee members.

5. Sailing Instructions

- 5.1. The Event Supplementary Sailing Instructions will be available on the BSC website and one hour before the first briefing, on the Official Notice Board. No paper copies will be provided to competitors.

6. Prizes

- 6.1. Prizes will be awarded by the International Moth Lowrider Class and Burton Sailing Club commensurate with the size and spectrum of the entry, but may include First Lady, First Youth, First Veteran, First Master, and 1st, 2nd, 3rd overall in both the First Past the Post and the Handicap competitions.

7. Disclaimer

- 7.1. Competitors participate in the event entirely at their own risk. See RRS 3, Decision to Race. The Lowrider Moth Class Association and the organising authority (Burton Sailing Club) will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained prior to, during, or after the event.

- 8.1. Each participating boat shall be insured with a valid Third-Party Liability Insurance with a Minimum Cover of £3 million.

9. Further Information

NOTICE TO ALL VISITORS - Invasive Species Procedure.

Before launching, all competitors are required to ensure that– your boat has been '**Checked, Cleaned and Dried**' for a minimum of two days prior to arriving at Burton Sailing Club.

This includes:

CHECK your equipment and clothing for live organisms– particularly in areas that are damp or hard to inspect.

CLEAN and wash equipment, footwear and clothing thoroughly. If you do come across any organisms, leave them at the water body where you found them.

DRY all equipment and clothing– some species can live for many days in moist conditions. Make sure you don't transfer water elsewhere.

ACCOMMODATION

Free camping for tents and caravans is available on site for 1 night before the event and any nights in between a joined day. Please register on the entry form.

Please note we do not have waste disposal facilities.

Dogs are allowed on site but must be under control at all times and are not permitted in the clubhouse or training centre

SITE ACCESS & PARKING

The car park nearest to the club house is for fishermen and visitors. Cars are permitted within the dinghy park to allow dropping or collection of boats and equipment but must be **removed immediately** to a designated car parking area.

BAR
