NOTICE OF RACE

1 Rules

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing, the RYA prescriptions and the rules of the relevant Class Association.
- 1.2 Competitors should note that Burton Sailing Club implements the RYA Racing Charter and that they will be required to undertake to sail in compliance with the Charter.
- 1.3 By entering and attending this event, all persons agree to abide by the Rules of Burton Sailing Club.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 Entry is open for any Phantom dinghy with a valid measurement certificate.
- 2.2 Eligible helms enter on the day, but preregistration is requested via <https://forms.office.com/r/ny7febi4zp>
- 2.3 Entry fees will be £15 per boat

3 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS AND RACING FORMAT

- 3.1 Sailing Instructions will be available online.

4 SCHEDULE

- 4.1 Racing will take place at Foremark Reservoir
- 4.2 Registration will be held at the BSC Race Office from 09.00am.
- 4.3 Competitor's briefing will be at 10.15am outside the club house
- 4.4 Four races are scheduled with the first race warning not before 10.55am.

5 SCORING

- 5.1 One race is required to be completed to constitute a series and there will be one discard if three or four races have been completed and no discards if less than three races are completed.
- 5.2 The low points system as provided in RRS Appendix A will apply

6 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- 6.1 Competitors participate in this regatta entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4 – Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage, personal injury/death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during or after the regatta.

7 INSURANCE

- 7.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of £3,000,000 per incident or the equivalent

8 MOVEMENT OF BOATS TO AND FROM FOREMARK RESEVOIR

In order to prevent the spread of non-native species there is a requirement to ensure that boats are clean before they visit the site using the principle of Check Clean Dry

This includes:

CHECK your equipment and clothing for live organisms – particularly in areas that are damp or hard to inspect.

CLEAN and wash equipment, footwear and clothing thoroughly. If you do come across any organisms, leave them at the water body where you found them.

DRY all equipment and clothing – some species can live for many days in moist conditions. Make sure you don't transfer water elsewhere.

ACCOMMODATION

Dogs are allowed on site but must be under control at all times and are not permitted in the clubhouse or training centre.

SITE ACCESS & PARKING
